

## **How to read Bachheimer.com in languages other than German.**

It is possible to read Bachheimer.com in languages other than German using the translation function available in the Google Chrome Browser.

This translation tool offers a very high linguistic level as long language is used in a neutral manner. Sometimes the order of the words is reproduced incorrectly, which can distort the meaning. Comments using Austrian dialect, plays on words or humorous references obviously cannot be accurately translated.

To activate this function, proceed according to the following steps.

1. Open the google chrome browser. On many smart phones this is the default setting.
2. Click on the three dots in the top righthand corner (underneath the cross) and then on "settings".
3. Then, In the bottom left of the screen, click on "advanced" and then on "languages".
4. Click on the downward arrow 'v' in the language box to open the menu.
5. Check that the language used to display the Google Chrome UI is English.
6. Click on "Offer to translate pages that aren't in a language you read" to activate the translate function.
7. Click on "add languages" and add German
8. Click on the three dots next to the word "German" to open the menu and click on "offer to translate pages in this language".
9. Return to browser and type in the address [www.bachheimer.com](http://www.bachheimer.com). A "translate this page" icon should now have appeared at the end of the address bar, next to the star.
10. Click on this icon and select the language in which you wish to read the site. If by any chance English or German is not available, then click on the three dots to open the menu and select the appropriate option.
